3.1. Registration of Teams and Athletes


National Federations can enroll their teams through the FIVB VIS until -15 days before the start of the competition, unless otherwise indicated.



Password: same as for the Beach Volleyball registration


Select the tournament with the respective gender:



Go to Tournament -> Teams -> New Confirm with "OK"




Double-click on the registered team

3.2. Right of Participation

An athlete wishing to take part in a CEV sanctioned competition must possess the nationality of the country whose national team he/she intends to play for and must fully comply with the requirements laid down in the CEV Regulatory Framework.

The right of participation shall become effective as soon as the teams' names appear on the Confirmed List established by CEV for each event. The Confirmed List will be published on the event's page on the CEV website and sent to all National Federations. It is the National Federations' responsibility to inform their athletes accordingly.

In addition, each team needs to present the <u>SV-01 Player's Commitment</u> from, each player needs to present the <u>Annual Health Certificate</u> to the CEV Supervisor during the Preliminary Inquiries, and completed the <u>FIVB Anti-Doping – We play it Clean!</u>, and <u>FIVB Prevention of Competition Manipulation</u> online courses.

Only athletes not suspended by CEV and/or FIVB are allowed to participate.

4. Financial Regulations

4.1. License Fee

For each athlete participating in a CEV competition in 2023 the respective National Federation shall pay, upon receipt of the respective CEV invoice, a license fee amounting to 50, - EUR per athlete.

4.2. <u>Registration Fee</u>

No registration fee is applied for the CEV Snow Volleyball European Tour 2023.

5. Uniforms and accessories

The organiser will provide jersey (top only) to the participating teams.

As per the provisions of the CEV Snow Volleyball Guidelines, the participating teams are responsible to bring their own long tight pants or shorts and close fitting long or short sleeves t-shirts. The uniforms must be consistent in style, length and color for all athletes in the team.

Athletes may use gear and accessories as defined in the CEV Snow Volleyball Guidelines.

6. Further Information

All necessary information about the competition will be circulated to the National Federations using the Official Communications and the event's Practical Info documents.

More event related details can be found in the CEV Snow Volleyball Competitions Regulations, CEV Snow Volleyball Guidelines, which are available on the CEV website.

National Federations are requested to apply early enough for visas for their delegation members whenever needed. The hosting National Federation shall be contacted to provide to the delegation concerned an invitation letter for the event.
