1. INTRODUCTION

This Official Communication No. 1 (Registration) supports all National Federations interested in registering teams for one of the CEV Clubs competitions.

It contains important information and explanations about registration, regulations, and other items for a smooth running of the competitions.

You will find a useful timeline / to-do-list in the [Organisation Guidelines - Chapter 1](#). Please read it carefully.

The CEV Office is available to help, should you have any questions, or need any assistance during this process.

2. 2024 REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Registration is done via the CEV database by completing the 01 form (one per gender), no later than:

Wednesday 07 June 2023 at 12:00 CEST.

Once you close the 01 form, the data is fixed and cannot be changed. The CEV will set the form as 'Accepted' as soon as it is checked. When the signed and stamped originals sent by mail are received, the CEV will set the form as 'Confirmed'.

More information about your registration is available in the Organisation Guidelines - Chapters 2 and 3.

3. ALLOCATION OF SLOTS

The allocation of slots per National Federation reflects the [CEV European Cups 2024](#) Ranking List.

Given that Russian and Belarusian teams are not eligible to register for participation in the CEV European Cups 2024, further to a decision made by the CEV Board of Administration which still stands, the vacant positions in the 4th Round will be allocated by respecting the sportive merits and by moving up the next best-ranked National Federations in accordance with the CEV European Cups Ranking List 2024 as follows:

- MEN
 - GER increases from 2 to 3 slots.
 - CZE increases from 1 to 2 slots.
 - POR promoted from 1-3 Rounds to 4th Round, with one slot in the 4th Round.
- WOMEN

- POL increase from 2 to 3 slots.
- UKR increases from 1 to 2 slots.
- HUN promoted from 1-3 Rounds to 4th Round with one slot in the 4th Round.

By increasing the slots in the CEV Champions League as per the provisions listed above, the remaining slots for the CEV European Cups competitions will be reduced accordingly in accordance with the CEV European Cups 2024 Ranking List.

The same allocation principle will apply to the remaining CEV European Cups.

According to the CEV Volleyball Competition Regulations Article 31.1 §1, The CEV only registers a maximum number of Clubs per gender and per National Federation, as follows:

- a) 5 in all Clubs competitions
- b) 3 in the CEV Champions League Volley

§2 The winning Club of a CEV Zonal Association Cup is not considered in the calculation of the maximum number of Participants for each and all Club competitions; when this club is qualified via one of the allocation options selected by its National Federation.

Therefore, the CEV Zonal Association shall until the CEV European Cups 2024 registration deadline confirm and communicate the teams that will compete in the CEV Zonal Association Cup.

Any CEV Zonal Association Cup shall be finalised:

- Men by 08 October 2023
- Women by 24 September 2023

The CEV Zonal Associations are kindly requested to inform CEV no later than **Monday 19 June 2023 at 23:59 CEST** to confirm the teams participating in their Zonal Cup – if any such competition is organised. The event shall feature a minimum four teams per gender representing four different countries.

4. CEV REGULATORY FRAMEWORK

During your participation in a CEV competition, you will have to use and comply with the CEV Regulatory Framework, mainly with the CEV Volleyball Competitions Regulations, Guidelines, and the Official Communications. These documents are available on the dedicated section of the CEV website: <https://inside.cev.eu/documents/volleyball-documents/>

You will also have to fill in CEV forms. These forms are available in your area in the CEV database.

For a full list of the CEV forms, please check the Organisation Guidelines - Chapter 3.

The CEV Board of Administration approved new changes to the CEV Volleyball Competitions Regulations, that can be seen on the CEV website.

Please be aware that by registering for the CEV European Cups 2024, you acknowledge that you have read and agreed on the terms of these Regulations and Official Communication.

Based on the number of registered Clubs, the CEV will determine the number of levels of a CEV competition, the Clubs qualifying directly to a level and those required to play in a prior level.

The allocation of teams within the levels will be made via a seeding – in accordance with the CEV European Cups Ranking List and the final standing of the National Championship (after any playoffs)– and a drawing of lots.

The allocation of the "visiting" and "hosting" Club status will be in accordance with the CEV Competitions Regulations, Article 14.3.2.

Moreover, in accordance with the CEV Competitions Regulations, Article 168, CEV may authorise for a valid reason only in the 32 Finals of the CEV Volleyball Challenge Cup, "Home and Away" match in the Host country of the lowest ranked National Federation, unless agreed otherwise by both Participants, according to the CEV European Cups Ranking List. The two concerned Clubs and their National Federations shall submit to the CEV, for approval, the relevant CEV forms no later than 15 days before the match.

12. USE OF LED SYSTEM

CEV Champions League Volley:

According to the CEV Board of Administration decision of 26 February 2021, the use of the LED system is mandatory from the 4th Round of the CEV Champions League Volley.

The clubs shall submit the "LED system application form" to the CEV for approval no later than 4 weeks before the start of the 4th Round.

CEV Volleyball Cup:

Static banner system as well as LED system are allowed.

The clubs shall submit the "LED system application form" to the CEV for approval no later than 4 weeks before the start of the competition.

CEV Volleyball Challenge Cup:

Static banner system as well as LED system are allowed.

The clubs shall submit the "LED system application form" to the CEV for approval no later than 4 weeks before the start of the competition.

The LED system application form is available on the CEV Cloud (download area).
The application form has to be submitted as specified in the application document.

13. COMMERCIAL RIGHTS

In accordance with the rights already granted to Clubs (Chapter 18 of the CEV Volleyball Competitions Regulations), the table hereafter shows the split of Advertising spaces on the Playing area between the CEV and the organising clubs.

In case no CEV partner is contracted by 30 September 2023 (date due to prior contractual commitments of CEV), 10% of the CEVs LED timing will be ceded to the clubs.

RESERVED PRODUCT CATEGORIES – CEV CUP & CHALLENGE CUP:

1. Betting and Gambling services*
2. Sports Equipment – Volleyballs and flooring
3. Sportswear

If not used, the CEV may release one or more of the above-mentioned categories by 30 September 2023 at the latest (date due to prior contractual commitments of CEV). In any case, the categories "Betting & gambling services" and "Sports Equipment – Volleyballs" will not be released.

*For the avoidance of doubt, although the "Betting & gambling services" sector and/or category is reserved by the CEV, the Organiser may exploit, based on prior agreement of the CEV, the category for the "National lottery", provided that their sports betting operations are in no way presented under the same brand as their National lottery operations. Thus, gambling and betting services are prohibited and the category will not be released by the CEV.

The CEV partner is the ultimate betting rights holder on a global basis in relation to the CEV Club Competitions including the CEV Champions League Volley, CEV Volleyball Cup and CEV Volleyball Challenge Cup.

14. BRANDING

For the upcoming season, all branding materials and layouts will be made available in due time after registration in the Download area on the CEV Cloud and need to be implemented by all the clubs for the season 2023/2024.

Further information on all graphics will be published in the next Official Communication.

15. MATCH TECHNOLOGY

For each match, the following match technologies is provided and used by the participating Clubs for the European Cups 2024:

- a. The CEV E-scoresheet
- b. The CEV statistics (only **Data** Volley)
- c. Video sharing
- d. ES Referee & Bench applications.

Here is below more information related to the usage of the CEV E-scoresheet and CEV statistics applications as indicated in the official Volleyball Competition Regulations:

- The E-scoresheet of a match is the only document which officially records the progress, results, Participants, events, protests, and sanctions of such match. Statistics of each match are collected by designated match officials of the Organiser (or home team) for CEV purposes.
- CEV is providing the necessary log-in credentials (including username & password) for the E-scoresheet and CEV Statistics applications to the Organiser (or home team) prior to the start of the CEV Competition.
- The Scorer shall complete the E-scoresheet and its printed version according to the Official Volleyball Rules and the CEV Guidelines.
- The Statistician shall complete the statistics file according to the CEV Guidelines.
- The Organiser shall provide free-of-charge the following facilities and resources during the CEV Competition to operate the CEV E-scoresheet and CEV Statistics in a professional manner:
 - Adequate hardware including laptop or tablet that is running the CEV E-scoresheet and CEV Statistics applications.
 - Ensure download and installation of the latest version of the CEV E-scoresheet and CEV Statistics applications.
 - Ensure stable and high-speed internet connectivity during the CEV Competition and necessary power supply to ensure a professional data collection and distribution to CEV and CEV Commercial partners.
 - Perform testing of the CEV E-scoresheet and CEV Statistics applications in the Competition Hall one (1) day before the start of the CEV Competition.
 - Ensure appointment of experienced e-scorer and statisticians during the CEV Competition to collect data and statistics during the CEV competition in a professional manner.

- For the CEV Statistics, live match statistics shall be delivered throughout the match during the CEV Competition by connecting to the CEV Database, making use of the credentials provided by the CEV.
- The Organiser shall prohibit any illegal or non-authorized collection, archiving and distribution of match related data and statistics during the live matches of the CEV Competition.

16. MEDIA RIGHTS & HOST BROADCAST PRODUCTION

The CEV is the ultimate media rights-holder of the CEV Club Competitions including the CEV Champions League Volley, the CEV Volleyball Cup and the CEV Volleyball Challenge Cup. The CEV has appointed the Sport Media Agency Infront as its exclusive global media rights distribution partner for the above-mentioned competitions.

The following media rights range of exclusivity and broadcasting standards which are duly stated in the CEV Volleyball Competition Regulations will apply during the CEV European Cups 2024:

1. CEV Champions League Volley

Media Rights

The CEV Sport Media Agency Infront retains the exclusive worldwide media rights with respect to the Men & Women CEV Champions League Volley. As a result, the participating clubs **do not hold** any media rights in their domestic territory.

It is the responsibility of the CEV and the CEV Sport Media Agency to produce all matches of the CEV Champions League Volley season 2023/2024.

In order to ensure a professional broadcast production, the participating clubs must provide upon request to CEV and its Sport Media Agency the following facilities and services on a **free of charge** basis:

- Camera platforms for one (1) or two (2) cameras centralised above the court and at the appropriate angle to produce a TV signal of international standard.
- A minimum number of commentary positions for each match to be located on the same side of the main camera and as close as possible to the playing field.
- Access to match data/statistics for the host broadcaster and the TV graphic operator.
- Adequate space in the TV and SNG compound for TV transmissions and production vans.

- One (1) fully furnished office for the CEV Sport Media Agency team on-site.
- Support to access the venue, TV compound and other broadcast areas.

2. CEV Volleyball Cup & CEV Volleyball Challenge Cup

Media Rights

With respect to the domestic matches only, the CEV is granting to the Participating Clubs the non-exclusive domestic media rights in the territory.

Host Broadcast Production

The participating clubs shall respect and fulfil the requirements stated in the CEV Volleyball Competitions Regulations and indicated below:

For the avoidance of doubt, any domestic matches produced by the Participating Clubs during the CEV Volleyball Cup and CEV Volleyball Challenge Cup shall respect the following World Feed signal format and signal delivery requirements:

Audio configuration	Minimum four (4) audio channels for international stereo sounds and 2 nd language commentary mix (if applicable)
Microphones	Min. six (6) including one (1) net microphone to capture atmospheric

TV graphics	Provided by the CEV and its Sport Media Agency (via FTP or cloud)

For the avoidance of doubt, the World Feed signal of each produced match must be delivered to the CEV and its Sport Media Agency free-of-charge via satellite according to the following standards:

- Uplink to an established European satellite
- Book the corresponding satellite space (including the end-to-end test synopsis)
- Provide an encrypted satellite feed (also called BISS code)

In order to ensure a professional broadcast production, the participating clubs must provide upon request to the CEV and its Sport Media Agency the following facilities and services on a free of charge basis:

- Camera platforms for one (1) or two (2) cameras centralised above the court and at the appropriate angle to produce a TV signal of international standard.
- A minimum number of commentary positions for each match to be located on the same side of the main camera and as close as possible to the playing field.
- Access to match data/statistics for the host broadcaster and the TV graphic operator.
- Adequate space in the TV and SNG compound for TV transmissions and production vans.
- One (1) fully furnished office for the CEV Sport Media Agency media and production team.
- Accommodation (full board) – up to 2 rooms for the CEV Sport Media Agency staff on-site provided that they are requested minimum 2 months before the start of each match.

Lastly, comprehensive TV production manuals and on-screen graphics package will also be distributed to each participating club and appointed host broadcasters.

17. DIGITAL & SOCIAL COVERAGE

The rising of mobile phone users and social media changed the way we look at the sport of Volleyball including our engagement to that unique sport. There are many different social media platforms like Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, and YouTube. Fans worldwide can use these social media platforms conveniently in their daily lives. Social media has also become an important tool for promoting events, distributing content, attracting new readers, and creating more engagement to teams and athletes.

The participating clubs should use social media to promote the CEV Clubs competitions. You may find below industry standards as well as social media tips that can be used throughout the season:

- Go “behind the scenes.” Make fans who are not at the event feel like they are there (and want to attend next time) by showing the scene on social media accounts. (e.g. show what the players are doing in their off time, before the game, etc.).
- Quote players: people love sharing a great quote. Make sure you use quotation marks and attribute it to the speaker.
- Think quality not quantity.
- Interaction between fans and athletes: when you post an interesting fact about a player, tag the athlete.
- Cross-post to other media. Make posts by attaching photos and videos of the event.
- Interact with people at the event. Share newsworthy posts by fans and credible sports journalists.

Participating clubs are also expected to engage and support the CEV Digital & TV department with the following actions:

- Promote the events via their own social media channels on a regular basis.
- Use the official competition hashtags whenever posting about it.
- Access and use CEV Social Media Graphics creator platform

 - The Organisers of the 1st Round tournaments will be appointed by the CEV after sending their bid by Friday 04/08/2023 at the latest.
 - The Pool Winners and 2nd Ranked teams will qualify to the 2nd Round that will be played as 1 pool (1 pool with 4 teams)
 - The Organisation of the 2nd Round Tournament will be granted to the highest ranked team according to the CEV Champions League Volley 2024 ranking.
 - The pool winner and 2nd Ranked team of the 2nd round tournament will advance to the 4th Round of the CEV Champions League Volley 2024. No 3rd round will be played.

3. CEV Champions League Early Rounds – Bidding Process & Conditions

Bidding Process

As mentioned previously, the CEV Champions League Volley 2024 Early Rounds will be played as tournaments. The teams registered in the CEV Champions League Volley Early Rounds are invited to send their bidding candidature for the organisation of the CEV Champions League Volley 1st round Tournament by Friday 04/08/2023 at the latest.

If no or not enough team(s) come(s) forward with a bid to organise one of the 1st Round tournaments, the CEV will determine the respective organiser(s) following a Drawing of Lots involving the teams previously drawn in the same pool.

The distribution of costs related to the organisation of the CEV Champions Volley 2024 early Rounds Tournaments is as follows:

- Transportation:

- Each participating team shall cover the cost of their own international transportation.
- The organiser shall cover the local transportation.
- Accommodation:
 - The organiser shall cover the accommodation of the participating teams, CEV officials and match officials according to the CEV Volleyball Competition Regulations.
- TV production:
 - CEV and the CEV Sport Media Agency shall be in charge of the costs of the TV production for all matches.
- Per Diem:
 - The organiser shall cover the costs of the per diem for the CEV officials and match officials.

In the CEV Champions League Volley 1st-3rd Rounds, the arrival date of the CEV Supervisor is 2 days before the tournament before 18:00.

If not used, the CEV may release one or more of the above-mentioned categories by 30 September 2023 at the latest (date due to prior contractual commitments of CEV). In any case, the categories “Betting & gambling services” and “Sports Equipment – Volleyballs” will not be released.

*For the avoidance of doubt, although the “Betting & gambling services” sector and/or category is reserved by the CEV, the Organiser may exploit, based on prior commercial agreement with the CEV partner AMI.

The CEV partner is the ultimate betting rights holder on a global basis in relation to the CEV Club Competitions including the CEV Champions League Volley, CEV Volleyball Cup and CEV Volleyball Challenge Cup.

Match Technology

- Mandatory usage of the CEV E-scoresheet and the CEV Statistics (CEV to provide access details)
- The Organiser shall provide free of charge the following facilities and resources during the CEV Competition to operate the CEV E-scoresheet and CEV Statistics in a professional manner.
 - Adequate hardware including laptop or tablet that is running the CEV E-scoresheet and CEV Statistics applications.
 - Ensure download and installation of the latest version of the CEV E-scoresheet and CEV Statistics applications.
 - Ensure stable and high-speed internet connectivity during the CEV Competition and necessary power supply to ensure a professional data collection and distribution flow.
 - Perform testing of the CEV E-scoresheet and CEV Statistics applications in the Competition Hall one (1) day before the start of the CEV Competition
- Challenge system is recommended but optional during the CL Early Rounds

Media Rights & Match Production

The CEV is the ultimate owner of the media rights in relation to the CEV Champions League Volley.

The CEV has appointed Infront as its exclusive media rights agency responsible for managing and distributing on its behalf all media rights of the CEV Champions League Volley worldwide from the Early Rounds to the Super Finals event.

The production and delivery of the signal of all matches of the CEV Champions League Volley is the sole responsibility of the CEV and its media partner Infront. In other words, the appointed Organizers and the Participating Clubs will not have to produce any matches while hosting and during the season.

Organizers and Participating clubs are only requested as duly indicated in the Volleyball Competition Regulations to facilitate the on-site TV production implementation including venue access/accreditation, building of additional camera platforms, power supply, provide furniture for commentary positions (up to 2 commentary positions per match) & necessary parking spots.

4. Marketing & Digital Promotion

The CEV Champions League Volley is the best Club Competition in the world. As such, the Participating Clubs shall promote the upcoming Champions League season via marketing activations including digital promotion, ticketing sales, and branding.

The rising of mobile phone users and social media changed the way we look at the sport of Volleyball including our engagement to that unique sport. There are many different social media platforms like Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, and YouTube. Fans worldwide can use these social media platforms conveniently in their daily lives. Social media has also become an important tool for promoting events, distributing content, attracting new readers, and creating more engagement to teams and athletes.

The participating clubs should use social media to promote the CEV Clubs competitions. You may find below industry standards as well as social media tips that can be used throughout the season:

- Go “behind the scenes.” Make fans who are not at the event feel like they are there (and want to attend next time) by showing the scene on social media accounts. (e.g. show what the players are doing in their off time, before the game, etc.).
- Quote players: people love sharing a great quote. Make sure you use quotation marks and attribute it to the speaker.
- Think quality not quantity.
- Interaction between fans and athletes: when you post an interesting fact about a player, tag the athlete.
- Cross-post to other media. Make posts by attaching photos and videos of the event.
- Interact with people at the event. Share newsworthy posts by fans and credible sports journalists.

Participating clubs are also expected to engage and support the CEV Digital & TV department with the following actions:

- Promote the events via their own social media channels on a regular basis.
- Use the official competition hashtags whenever posting about it.
- Access and use CEV Social Media Graphics creator platform
- Share on their social media behind the scene photos and video footage, showing the social side of players and staff, which can be re-tweeted or shared further on by the CEV.
- Provide the CEV with additional content to distribute on social media: the best promotion comes from the players themselves.

- Produce additional video material, such as mixed zone interviews in English, for publishing across social media channels.
- Engage with the CEV and other participating clubs on social media by liking, sharing, reposting, following, retweeting content.

If no or not enough team(s) come(s) forward with a bid to organise one of the 1st Round tournaments, the CEV will determine the respective organiser(s) following a Drawing of Lots involving the teams previously drawn in the same pool.

2. CEV Accreditation System

It is mandatory to use the CEV Accreditation System for all CEV Volleyball European Cups competitions 2024.

You can access the accreditation system via this [link](#) or via Club Area on the CEV Database.

The log-in credentials are the same used for the administration login to the CEV database. Those clubs that already used the Accreditation System may continue using their old username and password. The clubs that are first time accessing the Accreditation System shall confirm the account upon logging in.

Furthermore, there is a Badge Manager for the printing of the Badges for the home matches. Each club is responsible for printing the badges for their players and team officials for the entire season (excluding Final phase of the respective competition). In addition, the badge can be printed on the dashboard by downloading every badge separately.

The guidelines on how to navigate through the software are available within the documents area in the accreditation system.

3. Branded nets

All teams participating in the CEV Champions League will receive a branded net from CEV. The latter will be shipped to the address inserted by each team in the CEV database.

4. Application for LED system

As a reminder, the use of LED system is mandatory as from 4th Round.

All teams shall download the LED system application form from the CEV cloud here <https://cloud.cev.eu/url/ag3vrcfpzpc3aur>.

The fully compiled form must be sent electronically to CEV for approval:

- For 1st –2nd rounds, if applicable, by **Friday 15 September 2023**
- For 4th round by **Monday 16th October 2023**

The official LED playlist will be provided by CEV and be made available in the Download area of the CEV Cloud.

5. Team Uniforms

When ordering the team uniforms, clubs must make sure they are produced according to the CEV Volleyball Competitions Regulations and CEV Organisation Guidelines for Clubs.

All teams are requested to proceed as follows:

1. SPONSOR APPROVAL:

All sponsors appearing on the uniform shall be approved by CEV through the CLS form.

2. TEAM UNIFORM APPROVAL:

Any approval of team uniform shall only be valid if all sponsors are uploaded and approved in the CLS form. The uniform may be formally approved in case the production of the latter is launched before the activation of the form in the CEV database.

After approval of the sponsors through the CLS form, teams are required to upload the layout in colour of their 2 sets of uniforms, shirt and short, with a front side and back side view into their club folder created on the CEV cloud.

CEV must be informed of the upload by a short email to graphics@cev.eu.

3. COMPETITION LOGO BADGE:

The CEV Champions League Volley 2024 badge has to figure on the team uniform as from the first match, namely on the right sleeve for jerseys with sleeves or on the upper right chest for jerseys without sleeves (see layout hereafter).

The logo badge shall be integrated directly during the production of the jerseys.

N.B.: CEV will not produce any badges.

Production of banners (including CEV positions), backdrop, poster, digital promotion and tickets is compulsory. Any other promotional material with CEV identification markers shall be uploaded for approval.

However, all the relevant information and logos must be included in the design layout produced by the clubs, namely CEV logo, competition title and logo, CEV Official partner's logo. The production of an official brochure / official program is not mandatory.

All graphics will be available for downloading from the CEV Cloud. All Organisers have the opportunity to review the basic Brand Guidelines, to download and use the official competition logo and graphic devices in various formats, as needed.

7. Court Layout

Following to CEV Volleyball Competitions Regulations and Champions League Volleyball Brand Guidelines all clubs participating in the Champions League Volley 2024 are requested to provide the court layout according to the conditions displayed hereafter.

All **floor stickers** must be produced with an identical approach and style. Identical style means, if possible, similar background for floor stickers F1, F2, F5 and F6 (recommended are transparent or darker backgrounds). Floor stickers with white background should be avoided.

Floor stickers F3 (competition title) and F4 (Host city) are mandatory and must always be presented with transparent background. Host City must be promoted in writing and in white colour (no city logo).

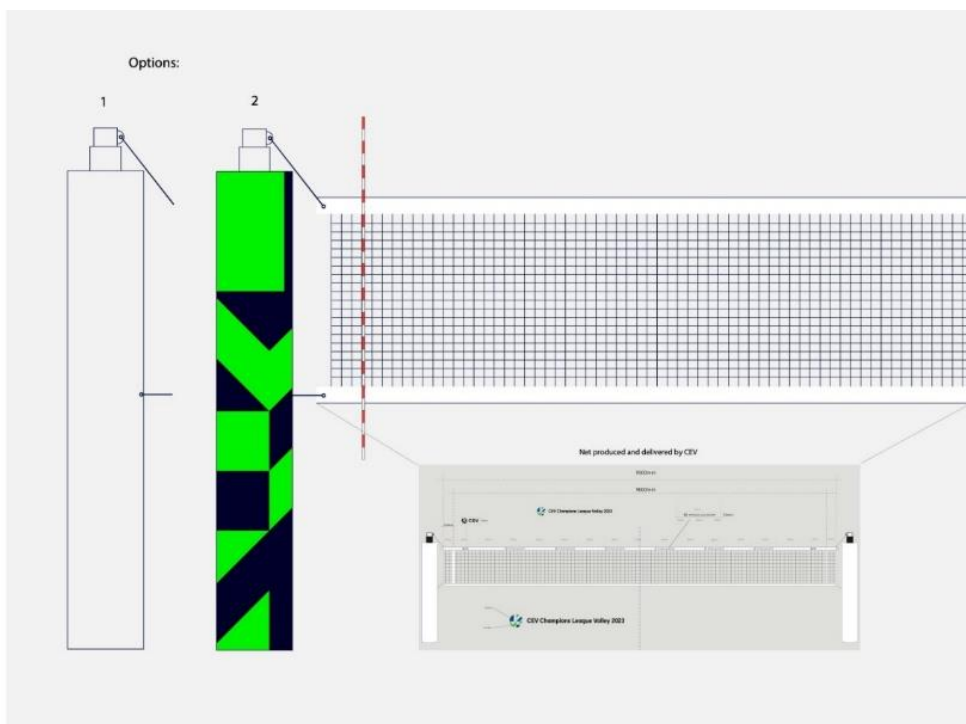

8. Court Layout – 1st – 2nd Round

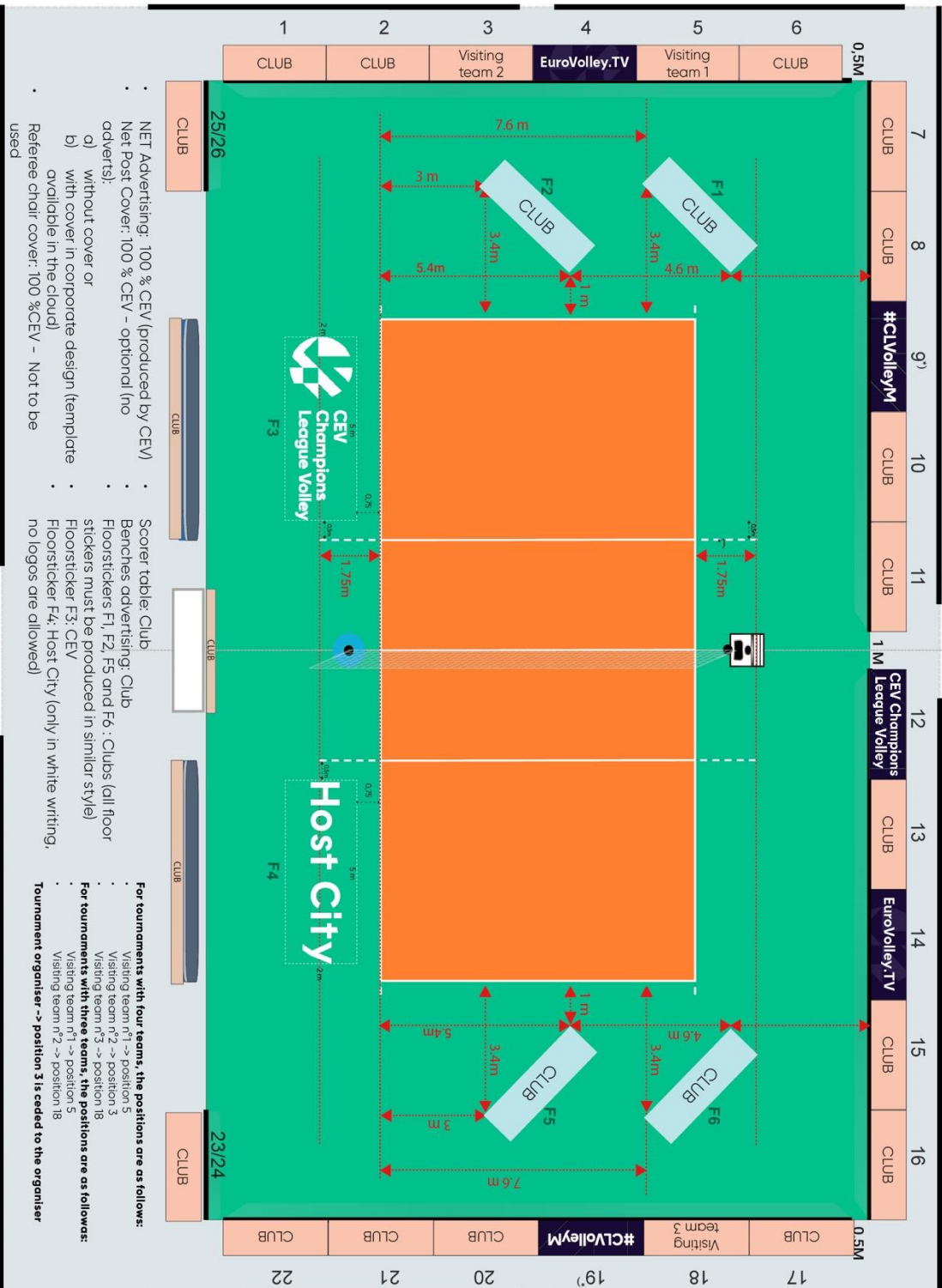

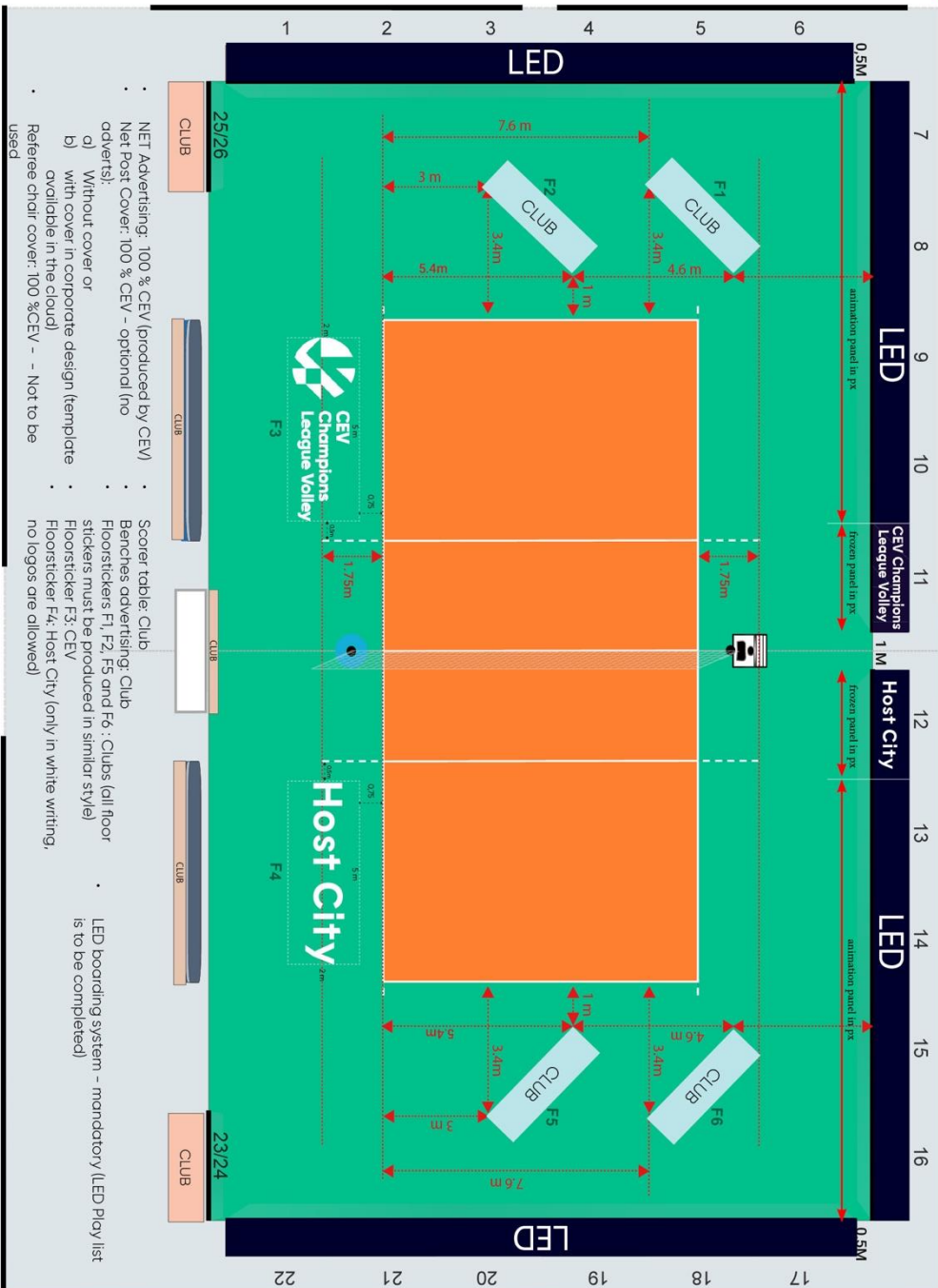
