MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Minimum 3 participating countries regardless the total number of participating clubs

Reporting of the competition stages, results and final standings of the Zonal competition.

This must be sent to beachclubs@cev.eu or through the applicable CEV Competition Management platform as indicated by the Beach Volleyball Department.

Representation of each Club by minimum 4 athletes and competition format of minimum 2 teams in each Club v Club match is compulsory.

Players participating in the Competition must hold a national licence issued by the National Federation by which the athlete and the Club are associated for the specific season determined under the conditions defined by the respective National Federation.

Enforcement of the official FIVB Rules of the Game. Exceptions, as indicated in the CEV Beach Volley European Cup Official Communications

FIVB homologated ball

Prize money is recommended but not compulsory.

Respecting the event category Organising Terms & Conditions

Organising terms and conditions:

- Only one event can be homologated in each Zonal Association for this to be a qualifying event to the CEV Beach Volley European Cup 2025.
- The Zonal Association Clubs Competition must be completed by July 13th 2025 the latest.
- Competition parameters (registration deadline and procedure, competition format, seeding, participation fee) in line with the Zonal Association regulatory framework
- o Minimum image and identity guidelines to be provided by CEV, including the court layout.
- Confirmed clubs/athletes lists latest 7 days before.
- o Infrastructure and facilities compliant with the FIVB Rules of the Game
- Assignment of one Supervisor and minimum one International/Candidate referee.
- o Minimum two referees per court and compulsory use of CEV Beach Volley Clubs Competition Scoresheet
- o Post event report to be sent to the CEV Beach Volleyball Department (<u>beachclubs@cev.eu</u>) on the first working day after the event (before 13:00 CET time latest), including results, final standing and pictures.

The winner of the Zonal Association Clubs competition obtains the right to compete in the Beach Volleyball European Cup. This spot is not transferrable.

No allocation of World Ranking points or points towards the CEV Beach Volley European Cup NF Ranking.

If CEV homologation is granted, the form duly signed and sealed will be returned to the Zonal Association.
